The overall purpose of the online course is to give its participants orientation in the theoretical and practical dimensions of leadership of Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel, India's Iron man; life and times of Sardar Patel; his legacy; his genius; the superb administrator; the secularist with a difference; making of a Gandhian nationalist; his role in leading the satyagraha; his economic ideas; his effort to reor-

ganize the states for unification of India after freedom and national reconstruction following independence and his concept of the unified World Order for Global Peace.

The course for the Indian diaspora and international participants will be in collaboration with Indian Mission and Indian Council for Cultural Relations as part of the commemoration of 75th Years of India's Independence - Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav. From February 2023, we will conduct Eight online certificate courses that would be hosted by 95 Indian Mission with support from ICCR.

This online course is aimed at enhancing the understanding of Indian spiritual and cultural heritage as well as the tre-

mendous contribution made by Sardar Patel during his life which was great in-

deed, his contribution in the next century when the world is facing many challenges could be even higher.

The courses will be conducted by Dr. Shobhana Radhakrishna and her team. The course will be interactive and participatory and is a non-credit program. After the completion of the course, participants will be given a digitally signed certification. The online course will be spread over three weeks-60 minutes once a week every Saturday in January 2023 on a virtual platform.

- Sardar Patel's role in leading various satyagraha in the freedom struggle
- Sardar Patel's philosophy/ideology, vision, and national reconstruction

Dr Shobhana Radhakrishna was born and brought up in Mahatma Gandhi's Ashram in Sevagram near Wardha in Maharashtra. She has cultivated a



strong ideological connection with Mahatma Gandhi's ideals since childhood. For the past two decades, she has attempted different ways of spreading Mahatma Gandhi's philosophy to people in India and abroad by giving lectures, workshops and Gandhi Katha.

Dr. Radhakrishna has travelled to 42 countries and presented lectures and Gandhi Katha. During the commemoration of the 150th Birth An-

niversary of Mahatma Gandhi starting from 2018 to 2021, She has delivered an online Gandhi Katha hosted by Indian Mission accredited to 135 countries. Through the virtual medium, Gandhiji messages have reached wide and far. On 30 January 2022, Indian Missions accredit-

ed to 90 countries hosted the online tribute by Dr Radhakrishna to pay homage to Mahatma Gandhi on his 74 Martyr's Day. Indian Mission in 90 countries hosted the talks by Dr Shobhana Radhakrishna to commemorate the Salt Satyagraha, Bardoli Satyagraha, and Quit India Movement in 2022. She gave talk on Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on National Unity Day 2022, which was hosted by 120 Indian Mission supported by ICCR.
